Grace and peace to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Thank you so much for joining us in prayer for the people, the community, and the future of Epworth Methodist Church of Aylett. We know that God loves to bless His people, and He answers our prayers when we seek Him earnestly. As we join together over the next 45 days we expect God to do great things!

We invite you to pray through the provided prompts and Scripture. Feel free to expand your personal prayers around each prompt as the Lord leads. Please spend at least a few minutes in your prayer time listening for God's response.

We are asking for vision and direction. And we believe the Lord when He promised to pour out His Spirit on all flesh, sending visions to the old and young for the edification of His people. We look forward to hearing what He reveals to each of you as we journey together toward God's new thing here at Epworth!

As God sends you ideas, visions, and thoughts for the future, we encourage you to jot them down and drop them in the offering plate or the box at the back of the sanctuary. At the end of our 45 days of prayer we will gather all that God as shown us and share His picture for our future as a congregation. Please plan to join us on October 5th for lunch and a time of visioning and planning around what God has revealed!

Prayers of Preparation

Day 1: Clean Hearts Scripture: Psalm 51:10-12

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

Focus: Centering Ourselves in God

Prayer: Abba, Jesus told His disciples that Your Word had washed them clean, but still He washed their feet. We need your cleansing to remove the sin, sadness, and stains of the world from our hearts. Search us today for anything that keeps us from your will and your Spirit. Fill us with Your joy as protection against the day-to-day weariness of the world and incline our spirits toward Your will. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 2: Right Thoughts Scripture: Proverbs 21:21

Whoever pursues righteousness and love finds life, prosperity and honor.

Focus: Orienting Our Thoughts to God

Prayer: Lord, we need your help to orient our thinking toward your righteousness and love. Help us to embrace the renewing of our minds Your Word promises. Align our thoughts each moment to Your perfect thoughts, righteousness, and love.

Day 3: Comforted Souls

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves have received from God.

Focus: Giving Our Grief to God

Prayer: Abba, our hearts are filled with wounds. We have faced illness, loss of loved ones, loss of friends, loss of self, loss of community, brokenness in our relationships, and many other heartaches that leave us grieving. Your Word promises that You will use all those things for our good as we walk with You. We lift our pain and grief to you and ask that You would comfort us in our sorrows until You make us whole and healed. In Jesus name, by the Presence of the Comforter, and for Your honor and Glory. Amen.

Day 4: Giving Forgiveness Scripture: 2 Corinthians 2:5-8

If anyone has caused grief, he has not so much grieved me as he has grieved all of you ... Now instead, you ought to forgive and comfort him, so that he will not be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow. I urge you, therefore, to reaffirm your love for him.

Focus: Restoring Relationship with Brothers and Sisters in Christ

Prayer: Lord, we come before you grieved by brothers and sisters who have done us wrong in past years. Some of the hurts are recent, stemming from struggles over direction in our congregation. Some of the hurts are old and almost forgotten, but still festering, leaving a seed of bitterness in our relationships with our church family. Today, I offer forgiveness to {speak any names that come to mind here} for all that has been done. I pray You would forgive them, and that You would help me to let go of any lingering offense or anger so that sorrow will not overwhelm them and the unity of Your family in our congregation can be restored. In Jesus name, by whose blood we are forgiven, amen.

Day 5: Receiving Forgiveness Scripture: 1 John 2:12

I write to you, dear children, because your sins have been forgiven on account of his name.

Focus: Restoring Relationship with God

Prayer: Abba, I come on my knees today knowing I have sinned against You. I have hidden my sins in the hopes You would not see them, and in the fear You would not forgive them. But Lord, today I confess these sins before You {speak anything the Lord brings to mind} because Your Word says You are faithful to forgive all our sins. I receive that forgiveness and thank you. In Jesus name, and by His blood, amen.

Day 6: Healing

Scripture: James 5:14-16

Is any one of you sick? He should call the elders of the church to pray over him and anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up. If he has sinned, he will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed.

Focus: Restoring Our Physical Bodies

Prayer: Almighty Creator, who knows every hair on my head, who knit me together in my mother's womb, and who knows the number of my days, I ask Your healing for my body. Lord, where I have {speak whatever illness, disease, or brokenness in your body needs healing} I ask that You restore my body to wholeness for as long as I am living here. Restore me to do Your will and teach me to be a good steward of my body so I can stay in Good health to serve You. In the name of Jesus, by whose stripes and in whose hands are Your healing, amen.

Day 7: Overcoming Fear

Scripture: John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you may have tribulation; but be of good cheer for I have overcome the world.

Focus: Being Encouraged By Christ

Prayer: Lord, the work You call me to is beyond me. Your enemies seek to devour me and separate me from You. My heart fears failure, destruction, loss, and even disappointing You. There are so many things for us to fear in our frailty. The sense of threat is overwhelming and can lead us to worry, anxiety, depression and even blind panic. But God, You call us to be courageous, because You have promised to be with us. Jesus made that promise again at His ascension. Be near us in our fear and make us more than conquerors as we hold fast to the promise of Your presence and the certainty of Your faithfulness. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 8: New Wineskins Scripture: Matthew 9:17

Neither do men pour new wine into old wineskins. If they do, the skins will burst, the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. No, they pour new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved.

Focus: Becoming Vessels for Holy Spirit

Prayer: Almighty, Majestic God, You invite me into the work of Your kingdom and call me to be a dwelling place for Your very own Spirit. Remake me Lord, mind, body, heart, and soul. Remove everything in me that is not compatible with Your Spirit and make me supple and ready to be filled with Your glory and grace. In Jesus name, and by Your Spirit, and all for Your honor and glory, amen.

Day 9: Fresh Vision

Scripture: Philippians 4:8

Finally brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things.

Focus: Orienting Our Vision to God's Vision

Prayer: Lord, our eyes are easily distracted and our hearts discouraged when our sight is filled with the trials and obstacles that surround us. Help us to fix our hearts and minds on the beauty of Your work all around us. Inspire us to see Your hand and paths in our families, our community, and our congregation. Let our vision be aligned with Your vision so we can see Your glory. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 10: Lively Unity Scripture: Proverbs 4:23

Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

Focus: Unity Around Our Heart as God's Family

Prayer: Father, Your Word tells us that Your people are bound together by the Holy Spirit, who provides a unity of love and grace, centered on Jesus Christ, to Your family around the globe and down through all the ages. Grant us the eyes to see one another as Your family, drawn together as a congregation at Epworth at Aylett to use all our diverse gifts, perspectives, and ideas to build Your kingdom and reach the lost. Fill us with our identity as Jesus' church, that He is building, so the gates of hell cannot prevail against us. In Jesus mighty name, through the power of the Holy Spirit in and around us, and for the honor and glory of Your kingdom coming, amen.

Prayers for the Community

Day 11: Local Families

Scripture: Psalm 22:27, 30-31

All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord,

And all the families of the nations will bow down before him...

Posterity will serve him;

Future generations will be told about the Lord.

They will proclaim his righteousness to a people yet unborn—for he has done it.

Focus: King William County Families

Focus: King William County Businesses

Focus: Vision for Strengthening Singles for God's Kingdom

Scripture: Isaiah 46:4

I am he, I am he who will sustain you.

I have made you and I will carry you;

I will sustain you and I will rescue you.

Focus: Vision for Engaging Seniors for God's Kingdom

Prayer: Abba, we love that You promise that even in our old age You have plans and purposes for us, that You will be with us and sustain us. Lord, grant us a vision for loving our elders in the Aylett and surrounding community. Help us create paths for them to serve Your kingdom and connect with the younger generations who desperately need them. Grant us a vision that envelopes them in Your love and Your work. Focus: Vision for vibrant worship to embrace God's kingdom

Prayer: Almighty God, all of life is about worship. We offer ourselves as living sacrifices, bowed down before Your throne. Give us a vision of what it looks like for our people to worship You with our whole heart, mind, body, and soul. Provide all we need to establish worship that is filled with the Holy Spirit and glorifies Your name in all the earth. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 32: Discipleship Ministry Scripture: Matthew 28:19-20

"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you."

Focus: Vision for making disciples for God's kingdom

Prayer: Lord God, help us to envision discipleship as more than Bible studies and small groups. Give us the vision that Christ gave to His disciples, a life encompassing process that draws people into the family of God out of all the nations and makes them new, clothed in righteousness, growing in Christ, and walking in obedience in the light of Your kingdom. Day 33: Fellowship Ministry

Scripture: Acts 2:41

Focus: Vision for fellowship ministry to grow God's kingdom

Prayer: Lord, You command us to love one another. To do this well, we must know one another, spend time with one another, and grow together. Give us a vision for the fellowship ministries of the church that helps us to love one another in all the ways You call us to. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 34: Prayer Ministry Scripture: Philippians 4:6-7

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Focus: Vision for making prayer central in building God's kingdom at Epworth

Prayer: Abba, prayer is the foundation of all things in the kingdom of God. It is our conduit to the throne of grace and our constant communion with our Father in heaven. Prayer is the method by which You choose to move mountains, cast out demons, heal the sick, and reconcile the lost. Give us a vision for prayer ministry in the congregation of Epworth at Aylett. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 35: Missional Ministry

Scripture: Acts 1:8

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Focus: Vision for identifying and reaching our Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and ends of the earth.

Prayer: Lord, we often equate mission either with telling stranger about Jesus in our back yard or going far away to serve foreign people groups. Your vision of mission is different. We are called to be Your witnesses at home and abroad. Epworth already has a missional heart. Help us to have Your vision for how to align and build out those missions to grow Your kingdom wherever You desire to send us. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 36: GMC Ministry Scripture: Hebrews 12:1-2

Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.

Focus: Vision for working in connection with the GMC in Virginia and globally.

Prayer: Gracious God, You have connected us to a great cloud of witness through the Global Methodist Church. This organization is advancing Your kingdom all around the globe and here in Virginia. You have blessed us with connections in our conference and beyond. Grant us a vision for how to work with other congregations in Virginia, with the Conference itself, and with other GMC organizations outside Virginia as we embrace Your vision of making disciples of Jesus Christ and spreading scriptural holiness around the world.

Prayers for God's Will

Day 37: Faith

Scripture: Galatians 2:20

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Focus: Trust in the promises of God

Prayer: Abba, we come with the understanding that without Christ we can do nothing. None of our plans will prosper unless they are grounded in You. Yet, we step out in the faith that You have promised to be with us. You have promised to guide and empower us for the work of Your kingdom. And You have called us for such a time as this. Help us rest in this faith as we begin the new journey You are preparing for us. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 38: Hope

Scripture: Hebrews 11:1

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

Focus: Hope for God's Growth at Epworth

Prayer: Almighty God, we see a church filled with children and youth. We see families growing in faith and love for You and for one another. We see a vibrant congregation engaged with our community and with the world as we serve and share the gospel. Yet, that vision is not seen here in the world currently. Today, we declare that we hope for what is now only seen in our minds eye. We rest in the promise that Jesus is our hope, and that You will complete the good work You have begun. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 39: Spiritual Disciplines

Scripture: Philippians 4:9

Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.

Focus: Developing Spiritual Practices at Epworth

Prayer: Lord Jesus, we recognize that just like athletes need discipline to excel, and students need discipline to succeed, we need discipline to follow Your commands and be obedient to the prompting and the presence of the Holy Spirit. Help us to develop the spiritual practices that will ground us in the vine of Christ so that we can grow in faith and be prepared to follow You wherever You lead us. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 40: Spiritual Fruit

Scripture: Galatians 5:22-23

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

Focus: Receiving the Spirit's Growth in His Fruit

Prayer: Abba, we are so grateful that You do not call us to be loving, joyful, and peaceful in our own strength. Thank you that the promise of Holy Spirit's presence in us is a divine growing of His fruit in us. Help us to let go of our own striving for human control and human peace and love, instead, help us to rest firmly in the overflow of the Spirit in us. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 41: Spiritual Gifts

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 14:12

Since you are eager for gifts of the Spirit, try to excel in those that build up the church.

Focus: Identifying and Exercising the Gifts God has provided to build up Epworth.

Prayer: Holy Spirit, Your Word says You give gifts to Your people just as You desire to accomplish the building up of the body and the work of Your kingdom. Help us to identify the gifts You have given to the people of Epworth at Aylett. Help us to embrace those gifts for the fulfillment of Your vision for our congregation, to encourage one another in the use of our gifts, and to align our work with the gifts You have empowered us with. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 42: Spiritual Presence

Scripture: Psalm 27:1

The Lord is my light and my salvation, whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Focus: Confidence in the Presence of the Holy Spirit

Prayer: Holy Spirit, we know You are with us, but sometimes in a world that denies the supernatural it is hard to hold onto the reality of Your presence. Give us confidence that You are always with us, in us, and working through us. Strengthen our convictions and make us bold in Your work. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 43: Vision

Scripture: Revelation 21:5

He who was seated on the throne said, "I am making everything new!" Then he said, "Write this down, for these words are trustworthy and true."

Focus: Clarity of how God is making Epworth new

Prayer: Ancient of Days, thank you for hearing and speaking with us these last 42 days. We ask once again for clarity of vision for the ways You are making Epworth at Aylett new and fitting us for the work of Your kingdom. As we begin our sharing, planning, and preparations, guide our conversations and keep us in the paths You have prepared for us to walk. In Jesus name, amen.

Day 44: Love

Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:13

And now these three remain: faith, hope, and love. But the greatest of these is love.

Focus: Fullness with the love of God and love for God at Epworth

Prayer: Abba, we know that Your infinite, eternal, relentless love is the core of all that we are and the center of Your gospel. Fill us with Your love so that we can love You with all that we are. Fill us with Your love so that we can overflow with Your love to those around us. We ask in the name of the Son of Your love, amen.

Day 45: Gratitude

Scripture: Psalm 100:4-5

Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise;

give thanks to him and praise his name.

For the Lord is good and his love endures forever;

His faithfulness continues through all generations.

Focus: Gratitude for God's love, vision, and promises

Prayer: Abba, with all Your children, we cry thank you! We praise You for all that You are. We thank you for Your amazing love, Your glorious grace, the vision that You have for us and the promises that You will be with and You will accomplish all that You have set out to do. We thank You for inviting and enabling us to join You in Your work. In Jesus name, amen.
